#### O thou seeker of Truth!

Whatever thou hast heretofore heard was fancy, not truth; was tradition (or narration), not vision, for it was an explanation concerning the Rising of the Sun, but that explanation was during the night.

But in this Day the Light of Truth hath dawned and the world hath become illumined; and therefore whatever thou (now) hearest concerning the Sun is on the authroity of vision (or actual sight), not on tradition (or narration). Consequently, open thine eye so that thou mayest hear the Divine Voice. Be delivered from thyself, from the thoughts and superstitions, until thou mayest find Eternal Life.

Recollect thou how many imaginations (or fancies) thou had during thy life! Now it has become evident that they were all superstitions, not Truth. Now walk thou in the Path of Truth so that the shining Lights may encompass thee and thy soul find a new life.

Be thou quit of the superstitions of the Pharisees, so that they may not prevent thee from believing in the Christ. For the Pharisees were heedless of the real purpose of the Holy Scripture, and since they did not understand the meaning of the Pentateuch, they assalled His Highness, Christ. One said: "Christ must come from Heaven; this person has come from the womb of Mary!" Another said: "He must come from an unknown place; we know this one is from Nazareth." Another said: "Where is the Kingdom of the Messish?" Another said: "Where is the iron rod?" Another said: "Where is the throne of David, and how did the Messish sit upon it?" Another said: "Where is the Justice during the days of the Messiah, and the association of the wild beasts - wolf with lamb, leopard with young goat, asp with suckling babe?"

To be brief: As they did not understand the meaning of the Holy Scripture, they did not approve of His Hollness, the Spirit of God (i.e. Christ). They opposed Him, avoided Him; nay, they made Him an ornament of the cross. They took the liberty of treating Him with the utmost injustice.

Now too, (in this Day) the heedless ones are like unto the Pharisess and are not informed (or are ignorant) of the Truth of the Holy Scripture! Consequently, they oppose the Blessed Reauty (i.e. Baha'u'llah) and are of the scoffers.

Before long this Great Cause will change the dust-bin of strife, conflict and warfare into the Garden of Love, Affinity, Peace and Conciliation.

## Helen Bishop's letter to Mr. Lunt.

Dear Mr. Lunt .-

It is a great experience to go to Haifa, and one changes one's point of view on many matters. The Guardian is an example of how intellect can serve the spirit in a manner we of the West have never known. There is nothing emotional about the Guardian; he is a perfectly controlled and mature personality. I have never heard him recite an incident in which he was the major figure, or say anything which would in any way give him a chance to excel. This may sound very naive but the point is that Shoghi Effendi simply refutes all those theories with which our academies are surfeited; that everego is trying merely to maximate itself.

Shoghi Effendi is very impersonal and he speaks only of the Word and our Faith. His speech is rapid and his English is stunning when he speaks, the hours pass tirelessly. I should say that his most obvious characteristic is <u>Power</u>, but there is nothing arbitrary or even personal about it. Again and again he seems to convey to one that the Cause of Baha'u'llah will reach its aim and that we have only to be superlatively faithful and to be active and obedient. There is something about him that makes one believe that one can do anything if he requires it; for example, he told me to write, and somehow I simply must begin to do it.

Shoghi Effendi says that great world events will establish the Fatth. It depends only partly upon the Baha'is. The war is inevitable and great changes will result therefrom. Great Britain will lose her colonies. At present, the British Commonwealth is the greatest obstacle to the Commonwealth of Baha'u'llah. Russia will experience a change in regime. From America much can be expected. The form of the Administration established in America will become the form for the entire world. Also Germany has a great destiny. In an era of persecution they will exhibit a loyalty and devotion which makes them comparable to the Persians. Scholars, teachers and technicians from Germany will contribute much to the Baha'i Cycle.

Isn't this fascinating?

## ADDRESS OF ABDU'L BAHA

### to the

Theosophical Society of Scotland.

February, 1913.

It gives me great pleasure to be with you this evening and to take part in your delightful gathering, for you Theosophists, Praise be to God, are always independent investigators of reality, released from mere imitation of the customs of your forebears and ancestors. Your purpose in life is to achieve and welcome the knowledge of reality, no matter from what religion the light may dawn. The religions of today are all captives in the claws of custom and of blind dogma, for the absolute reality and dominant truth which prompted the foundation of the very religions in the past are entirely forgotten and certain blind observances of ritual and sacerdotal mummeries have crept in which are in entire opposition to the fundamental principles of Divine Religion.

True religion which comes from God, is founded for the purpose of illuminating the world of humanity and for the emancipation of the human race. It establishes a complete fellowship between all the hearts and unfolds before our vision the Kingdom of Heaven. But a thousand times, alas! Religions so founded have become the cause of contention and mutual strife, and today they are constantly waging war against each other. There is even bloodshed among their representatives, who engage in strife, ransack each other's possessions, and destroy each other's homes. What makes them do all these things? They do them because they are prisoners of blind dogma.

As an illustration, take anyone you meet. You ask him to what religion he belongs. He says he is a Jew. "Why art thou a Jew?" "Because my father was a Jew and my forebears were Jews. That is why I follow in their footsteps." Another man is a Musselman. "Why art thou a Musselman?" "My father was one, and my ancestors also." And if you put this query to the devotees of other religions they will give you the same answer. And indeed if you go through the whole category of the present-day religions you will find that in all of them numbers are following blindly; and that is a case of the "blind leading the blind". But if you inquire, you will find that they have never investigated the reality; for if they had done so, they would all have become unanimous and would work in harmony. If reality is one, then it is not subject to division; and this absolute reality is the foundation of all religions

The Theosophical Society has freed itself from such blind initation of what was thought and done in the past; and, soaring up toward the Heaven of Reality, is ever trying to investigate the deeper Truths which underlie all religions. Therefore I am very

happy.

As we look upon this world - the Macrocosm - and upon all that goes to make up men - the Microcosm - what do we find? We find that every organism is composed of single primordial atoms, and has come into existence through the interaction of the electric affinities inherent in them. Its existence is a scientific fact. Every given atom of these myriads of atoms has passed through multitudinous forms, and in every form it has manifested a particular virtue or power. For example, looking upon this flower, there is no doubt that it is composed of single atoms, simple elements. There was a time when the various substances composing it were all in the mineral kingdom, and during that period they underwent many transformations. Having completed their course in the Mineral Kingdom, these atoms ascended to the Vegetable Kingdom, and they will go on maybe for many hundreds of years continuing their journey through experiences in this vegetable life. One day this which is now a chrysanthemum may become a rose; another day it may form part of a carnation. Another day it may enter into the composition of a tree. In short, each indestructible atom goes on journeying first through the mineral kingdom, and then through successive stages of the Vegetable World. This is a fact in harmony with the laws of biology.

Now this atom having run its course through the vegetable kingdom ascends next into the Animal Kingdom, where again it has its varied experiences. Having finished these it enters the realm of humanity and travels through its many and varied stages. In short, this primordial atom has under-gone transformations through all the kingdoms and sub-kingdoms of life, and in consequence of these experiences it manifests in a certain form and possesses a particular virtue and power.

It is one of the philosophic epigrams of the East that everything is included in the All. Therefore every man during these multitudes of transformations is gradually learning to know the many aspects of that All, and in every TRANSFORMATION has the opportunity of acquiring fresh virtue, so that man may become the compendium of all the virtues of creation. This is an exposition of a Divine Mystery.

Philosophic man, or the inner man, is indestructible. He is ever existent. For the immortality of the soul is a fact not to be denied. The spirit is everlasting, it is illimitable. The rational proof of the immortality of the soul is as follows:— Man enjoys two realities, two verities (or aspects of Truth). The first aspect of this human verity is material; and the second aspect is spiritual. The aspect which is material is subject to non-existence. But the ideal aspect of man which is the spirit is indestructible. What does mortality or death mean? It means transference from one body to another body. Thus to take again the illustration of this flower; this flower you may say is doomed to death, it is dying. Why? Because it is losing its present form and is returning to its original constitution, which is mineral. But there is ever a conservation of energy lasting through all creations; so that even the

material constituents which make up this flower never die, but are constantly transformed. Thus, when grass is eaten by an animal, you may say that the grass is dead. But the real fact is that it has only lost its vegetable form and become absorbed into the animal kingdom, and through this process, animal life is made possible, the plant has never been lost.

So that we may say of annihilation that it is a process of transference from one form to another; but the elements are indestreutible. That is all that is meant by annihilation. Thus it is with the body of man, his material form that you see before you. The spirit leaving the body means that this temporal body having done its duty, will return to its original constituents and become part of the earth; but it still has an existence. So death means simply a step beyond the present conditions of life. In this way the material body of man may go through many forms and changes, and die and again be born, because it is used constantly in the making of various new forms and shapes.

At the same moment one body cannot occupy the same space as another. It may only occupy one space. Take for example, any given body - say a triangle. As long as it is a triangle, it cannot be a square, nor can it become a hexagon. It cannot become any other geometrical figure, for if it becomes a hexagon it cannot remain a triangle. One body can only be one shape at a time. So two forms cannot become part of one body at the same time. But, even as you are sitting here, your soul or mind or spirit, by whatever name you call it, contains all these various forms. At this very moment you conceive of a triangle, a square, a hexagon or a geometrical shape all at the same moment. Just at this time in your mind, in your SPIRIT, you may call up anything. There are these forms existing simultaneously, without having to be broken, and to replace one another in succession. They are all present in your spirit. In this way all forms exist in the spirit. There is no need of breaking one form, so that the spirit may enjoy another form. The spirit is independent of these forms. Therefore this is scientific proof that the spirit is eternal. Why do we enjoy the immortal spirit? It can never be transformed from one shape to another. It is able to contain all the shapes and forms in the world. This is selfevident. The spirit enjoys immortal life.

Another piece of evidence- this physical body of man, once in a while, is subject to sickness. At other times it gets well. Sometimes the body grows fat, at other times it grows the opposite way - all lean - so that the body goes through various conditions; but the spirit is ever the same. If the body grows lean the spirit grows not lean; if a man enjoys three hundred avoirdupois, his spirit does not weigh three hundred pounds. Therefore this Divine and Heavenly Absolute Reality which is in man is not subject to transformation or change. If one hand is cut off and the other arm is cut off, and the lower limbs are cut off, you will see that the man is going on living just the same, and his spirit is not mutilated. He is exactly the same man. The eternal spirit in him is undying. The third proof - what is death? Death means the losing of sensations or susceptibilities. While in a state of sleep, man's body lacks all sensation. His eyes do not see, his ears do not hear. The power of smell does not act. All the senses are at rest. They are asleep? Yet notwithstanding all this the man travels.

He journeys, he dreams. His spirit sees and his tongue speaks. In that very state of quiescence he is endowed with all his faculties. Now if man was made only of this material flesh he would not have these various conscious experiences while in a state of dream. This likewise demonstrates the fact that in the inner reality of man there is a second deeper reality by which everything is surrounded. Therefore it is another evidence that in man God has hidden another second reality, which second reality is entirely free from all the fatalities of life, ever going forward, never retrogressing; and this will show you that man enjoys this immortal and everlasting spirit.

The fourth proof: - While speaking you use the word "I". "I went there." "I came here." Who is this "I" that speaks within you? It can look out and see its own body. It is evidently the ego within (cognito ergo sum). Therefore there is a second indestructible reality in man. The fifth proof: - When you want to undertake a great thing you retire within this chamber of your own thought and wonder "Will it be profitable? Ought I to do this? What will be the result of this?" Who is this consultant within you? That consultant is the spirit. You consult with it and you get the proper opinion; and if the spirit dictates "Go and do it", you will go on and do it, and if it dictates "No. it is not profitable", you will not dare to do it. And this state is constantly working in man, and is the proof in regard to the immortality of the soul. That inner reality is the rider and your body is the charger. The body is like unto this glass, and the spirit within you is like unto the light which illumines the glass. Although the glass may be broken, the light will not be broken. Although the bulb containing the electric light goes through the process of dissolution, the light is not destroyed. It remains latent as electric energy; and another glass will come and take the place of its predecessor, and you will again have the light shining through it.

Man has had all this journeying through the various grades, and he is traveling still and will travel, until in the end he will reach a destination which is superior to his physical life. That is called the state of perfection; but he is constantly breaking these glasses and purifying them, making for himself, by degrees, a purer and purer vehicle until it becomes perfectly transparent. At one time this glass that is here before us was in the course of vitrification in the mineral kingdom. And in the same way there was a time when the constituents of our material body were in a vegetable kingdom. And at another time they were a part of animal life. Now they have come together so as to form the human body. Therefore although the glasses be shattered, the light of the spirit or the true reality will ever shine; and this is another proof. It is not a traditional proof - not a matter of belief and theory. It belongs to the philosophy of the Kingdom and it is unanswerable.

To take another line of argument: - The world of existence, the world of manifestation, by itself and in itself, cannot enjoy perpetuity. No, the phenominal world, or world of existence, has rather the capacity for receiving bounties and outpourings. There is a Reality which is central. The world of existence has emanated or issued from that central reality. As this material globe of ours - which in itself is not luminous - is vivified by rays emanating from the phenominal sun - for the sun is a star - so the spiritual rays issue from this stupendous center of life and immediately all are illumined thereby.

The greatest Divine outpouring is the appearance of Divine Masters in this world. These Divine and Heavenly Verities consist of one central Verity. But they have diverse Dawning-places; just as this electric light is always the same light, although it shines through various glasses. Here one day it shines through this glass, another day this glass is extinct and it will shine through another many glasses - but the energy which gives light is the same, without any difference. The Light is indivisible, it is one light; and although these Heavenly Masters, as far as their personalities are concerned, are different; as regards their Inner Nature they enjoy one central realm, and that one central realm emanates from the central spiritual sun. There are many mirrors from which the sun is reflected. Yet the sun is one. This is an astromomical question. For example: - Here on the map you have twelve rays issuing forth from the central body/ As you look, see that there is one center and one stellar body; but this stellar body is capable of transmitting many, many rays of light to all parts. One light gives forth these twelve rays. Similarly one sun, the phenominal sun, dawns at one time from the celestial sign of Capricorn; at another time it shines from the sign of Leo; at another time it will appear from the sign of Aries. It will shine from one point in spring, and again from another point in winter; but the sun is the same sun, and the ray is the same ray, although it passes through many signs. When the sun dawns from any particular sign, its heart is of a certain intensity. Similarly, there are differences in these Divine Manifestations, or "Masters"; but in reality they show forth the One Central Truth.

Man must never look at the Dawning-Points, he must ever look upward and see the Sun. He must be an adorer of the Sun, no matter from what Point it appears. He must recognize the Light, no matter from which Glass it has been admitted. For Light is illimitable, and man must attain to that state of divine perception. He must never limit himself to any one system. There are many mirrors reflecting the Light; but though all these mirrors should be shattered, the Light would remain. So long as we are seeking the Light and constantly turning towards it, we shall love the Light, no matter from which globe it may be shining.

And now I have made you quite tired.

O Thou Almighty God! Illumine dur minds. May the eyes of the blind be opened and the ears of the deaf unstopped. Arouse the hearts that are dead. Quicken the souls that are fast asleep.

A cablegram of the utmost importance has been received from the Guardian. Its appeal is directed to each individual Baha'i of the United States and Canada.

CONTRACT FOR PURCHASE AND TRANSFER TO PALESTINE BRANCH (OF THE) AMERICAN (NATIONAL SPIRITUAL) ASSEMBLY (OF THE) DUMIT PROPERTY SITUATED (AT THE) CENTER (OF) AREA DEDICATED TO SHRINES ON MOUNT CARMEL (HAS BEEN) SIGNED. FOUR YEARS LITICATION INVOLVING BAHA'I WORLD'S PRITITIONS (TO) PALESTINE HIGH COMMISSIONER (HAS BEEN) ABANDONED. OWNERS REQUIRE 4000 POUNDS (1.e. about \$20,000). HALF (OF THIS) SUM (IS) AVAILABLE. WILL AMERICAN BELIEVERS UNITEDLY CONTRIBUTE 1000 POUNDS (1.e. about \$5,000) BEFORE END OF MAY AND REMAINING 1000 POUNDS (1.e. about \$5,000) WITHIN NINE MONTHS. AMERICAN BEAUTHER BODY AMERICAN COMMONITY SUBORDINATE NATIONAL INTERESTS OF FAITH TO ITS URGENT PARAMOUNT REQUIREMENTS AT ITS WORLD

To this message the following reply was immediately sent: "American Baha'i community, acclaiming impressive victory which contributes to future consolidation Divine institutions, will with one heart fulfil glorious privilege conferred upon it by beloved Guardian."

In communicating this appeal to the Baha'i Community, the following brief explanation will reveal the significance of the facts which Shoghi Effendi has reported.

The "Dumit property" is an area on Mount Carmel which has seriously interfered with the Guardian's plan of safeguarding the vicinity of the Holy Shrines and of preparing the necessary land for the future construction of important world Baha'i institutions. Held by an enemy of the Faith, the property has been made the basis of law suits against the Guardian throughout the period of the last four years. In July, 1933, at Shoghi Effendi's direction, the National Spiritual Assembly sent to the High Commissioner at Jerusalem a petition setting forth the religious character of the Baha'i land on Mount Carmel and appealing for his favorable action on the Baha'i claims. That petition was not at the time reported to the believers because the Guardian wished the matter held confidential pending the final outcome.

Shoghi Effendi's cablegram, consequently, means these three things: first, that a tract of land of paramount importance to the development of the Baha'i World Center can be acquired; second, that the law suits which have interrupted that development and been burdensome are now a thing of the past; and third, that the Guardian has made a contract to purchase that area, fulfilment of which requires the American Baha'i community to contribute approximately \$5,000 to the Guardian before May 31, 1935, and an additional \$5,000 within nine months.

No Baha'! will overlook the fact that the progress of the Faith of Baha'u'llah, in its evolution to His World Order, depends upon the collective capacity of the believers to assist in strengthening the World Center at Haifa. From that Center, through the Guardian now and through the Guardian and the Universal House of Justice in the future, flows outward to the Baha'i community the spiritual inspiration and the administrative power which sustains our efforts, guides our actions and renews our souls.

As Shoghi Effendi declares: "Am compelled appeal entire body American Community subordinate national interest of Faith to its urgent, paramount requirement at its World Center."

While humanity plunges blindly forward to a destiny become inevitable, it is our most sacred and glorious privilege, our most compelling duty to Baha'u'llah Himself, to do our part in laying the foundation firmly, in true love and sacrifice, for the World Order that is to give mankind the blessing of the Most Great Peace. years of unceasing turmoil, so laden with anguish, so fraught with incalculable consequences to the future of civilization, have brought the world to the verge of calamity too awful to contemplate." (The Goal of a New World Order, page 10) "Ours, dearly-beloved co-workers. is the paramount duty to continue with undimmed vision and unabated zeal, to assist in the final erection of that Edifice the foundation of which Baha'u'llah has laid in our hearts, to derive added hope and strength from the general trend of recent events, however dark their immediate effects, and to pray with unremitting fervor that He may hasten the approach of the realization of that Wondrous Vision which constitutes the brightest emanation of His Mind and the fairest fruit of the fairest civilization the world has yet seen." (The Goal of a New World Order, page 28). And addressing the American Baha'is Shoghi Effendi has written: "In a world writhing with pain and declining into chaos this community - the vanguard of the liberating forces of Baha'u'llah - succeeded in the years following Abdu'l Baha's passing in raising high above the institutions established by its sister communities in East and West what may well constitute the chief pillar of that future House - A HOUSE WHICH POSTERITY WILL REGARD AS THE LAST REFUGE OF A TOTTERING CIVILIZATION." (America and the Most Great Peace, page 21).

Such is the significance of our united effort to fulfil the Guardian's present appeal.

Now, that the matter may proceed with all possible force and efficiency, will each local Assembly do its utmost to transmit to the National Fund a flow of special donations marked for the Guardian, that our Treasurer, well within the dates fixed in the cablegram, may in turn transmit to Shoghi Effendi the two Sums he requires. For its part, the National Spiritual Assembly will forthwith meet the problem of reducing its national budget to the lowest possible amount. Above all, we express the confident hope that all American Baha'is will take part in this magnificent enterprise, this holy and consecrated crusade under our Guardian's banner, even though in many circumstances the amount given may be only a tiny sum. What we are building is a true spiritual unity - the material needs of the Faith will all be met when that unity is attained!

# O thou daughter of the Kingdom!

Thy letter was received and its contents became evident. It was an indication of a prayer and supplication and a proof of attraction and enkindlement. Happy is thy condition that thou art in this state and in this firmness.

O thou daughter of the Kingdom! The Lord of the Kingdom and the Sun of Truth has sent forth a splendor and effulgence upon the world and the universe. All the contingent things found life and existence from the rays of that Effulgence, entered and became manifest in the Arena of Being. Therefore, all the objective phenomena are as surfaces of mirrors upon which the Sun of Truth has cast the rays of the Outpouring of Bounty. All these surfaces (different stages of life) are mirrors reflecting the rays of the Sun of Truth. The Outpouring is the One Outpouring, and the Effulgence is the One Effulgence. These complex and diversified mirrors are different from each other. Some of them are in a state of the utmost purity and clearness, reflecting the rays of the Sun of Truth, and the Effulgence of the Luminary is manifest and visible in them. On the other hand there are mirrors full of dust and dark, consequently they are deprived and bereft of any radiation.

The believers of God are the translucent mirrors, who, with the utmost purity and clearness, are reflecting the rays of the Orb of regions. Other communities are bedarkened and beddimmed like unto a stone and ademant. This condition is especially true of the people of hostility, animosity, oppression and tyranny, and the fenatical ones, who, on account of the accumulation of dust (prejudice) have become like unto the black stone, into which the rays of the sun do not penetrate and from which no light radiates.

Now we must not consider nor recognize these mirrors, which are deprived of every gift, as strangers and foreigners; neither should we speak of or know them as enemies or savages; nay, rather, must we recognize them as the members of our body, showing them love and affection; not as strangers but as associates; not as foreigners but as friends. One must become engaged in their training and education, sympathize with them and show pity to them, and lead them into the Heavenly characteristics, in order that the accumulated dust may disappear from the surfaces of those mirrors and the shining rays of the Sun of Truth radiate from them.

O thou daughter of the Kingdom! Beware! Beware! Be ye not a stranger to anyone, even if he be the lowest of savages on the face of the earth and knows nothing of God, or even if he be an enemy. Desire ye his association, aspire ye for his freedom and long ye for

his perfection, in order that hatred and dissensions, animosities and oppressions, cruelties and tyrannies, brutalities and falsehoods, pride and transgressions may be removed from among mankind, the universe become the Paradise of Abha, the world be transformed into the Kingdom of Heaven, the human race become angels and the individuals of the world of humanity become the manifestors of the Favors of the Glorious Lord. This is the perfection of the human world. This is the Divine Guidance of the Almighty.

O thou daughter of the Kingdom! Display ye the utmost charity toward the poor, the orphans and the helpless ones of all communities and nations and have ye for them exceeding consideration. Serve ye them like unto the real servants. Know ye them as excellent persons, and count yourselves day and night the thralls of mankind.

O thou daughter of the Kingdom! Know thou that supplication and prayer is the Water of Life. It is the cause of the vivification of existence, and endows glad-tidings and joy to the souls. Show thou attention to this matter as far as thou canst, and summon others to prayer and supplication.

Words spoken by Abdu'l Baha, June 15, 1912, New York City.

"I desire distinction for you. The Bahalis must be distinguished from others of humanity. But this distinction must not depend upon wealth - that they should become more affluent than other people. I do not desire for you financial distinction. It is not an ordinary distinction I desire; not scientific, commercial, industrial distinction. For you I desire spiritual distinction; that is, you must become eminent and distinguished from all else. You must become distinguished for loving humanity; for unity and accord; for love and justice. In brief, you must become distinguished in all the virtues of the human world; for faithfulness and sincerity; for justice and fidelity; for firmness and steadfastness; for philanthropic deeds and service to the human world; for love toward every human being; for unity and accord with all people; for removing prejudices and promoting universal peace. Finally, you must become distinguished for heavenly illumination and acquiring the bestowals of God. I desire this distinction for you. This must be the point of distinction among you."

Set aside every mention save the mention of God and abandon everything save the divulgence of the Testament, be attracted by the magnet of the Covenant that thou mayest see the triumph of the angels of the King of the Kingdom and the valor of the hosts of Might. By the Life of the Lord! the invincible power will indeed strengthen, the HOLY SERIRI will speak in thy mouth, the word of God will be revealed in thy heart, the sound of the trumpet of the Lord will gladden thee, the light of unity will shine from thy brow, the doors of success and prosperity will be opened upon thy face and the secrets of the Holy Books will be unfolded.

### LAST TALK GIVEN BY ABDU'L BAHA.

At the House of Abdu'l Baha. Haifa, Palestine.

November 19, 1921.

Talk given by Abdu'l Baha at the regular six o'clock evening meeting, called "The Persian Meeting", with Mr. John D. Bosch of Geyserville, California, present - the only one present from a foreign country among sixty friends who met at this time - just nine days before the Ascension of Abdu'l Baha, in fact, this was the last public talk given by Abdu'l Baha in the Persian Meeting when an American attended, before His Ascension.

(Interpreted by Mirza Mohammed Ali Afnan. Taken down in Persian by Dr. Lotfullah Hakim.)

Abdu'l Baha opened the meeting by saying to Mr. Bosch:
"Although you are here with these assembled friends and can
not speak with them nor they with you, yet you speak with one another
through the heart. The language of the heart is even more expressive
than the language of the tongue and is more truthful and has wider
reach and a more potent effect."

Mr. Bosch said: "This is a wonderful spiritual experience, to be here with the friends."

Abdu'l Baha said: "When lovers meet it may be that they can not exchange a single word, yet with their hearts they speak to one another. Thus do the clouds speak to the earth and the rain comes down; the breezes whisper to the trees; the sun speaks to the eyes of men. Although this is not actual speech, yet this is the way in which the hearts of the friends talk together. It is the harmony between two persons and this harmony is of the hearts. For instance, you were in America and I was in the Holy Land; although our lips were still, yet with our hearts we were conversing together. The friends here love you very much. They have a real attachment for you although with the tongue they can not express it."

Mr. Bosch said: "I am very glad. I love them too."

Abdu'l Baha said: "If this love is real and true, if it is from the heart, it will characterize itself by self-sacrifice. When the attachment is superficial, friends do not sacrifice themselves even to the extent of a hair's breadth. His Holiness Christ LOVED both His disciples and believers to such an extent that He Sacrificed His Life for them. His Holiness the Supreme (the Bab) LOVED the friends to such an extent that He have His Life for them. The Blessed Beauty (Baha'u'llah) LOVED the friends to such an extent that for their sakes He accepted a thousand difficulties and afflictions. He was banished from place to place. His properties were confiscated. He gave all - His family, His relatives, His possessions. He accepted imprisonment, chains and fetters. His Holy Person was imprisoned in the fortress of Akka until the last moment of His Life. He was made to suffer more calamities, afflictions and difficulties than could be enumerated. He had not an hour's comfort. He was continually under the greatest hardships and ordeals. What great persecutions He endured from His enemies! What great afflictions He bore from His own relatives! He accepted all these trials for our sakes so that He might educate us, so that He might make us illumined, so that He might make us Heavenly, so that He might change our character, change our lives, so that He might illumine our inmost self. All these troubles He accepted for our sakes. He did indeed sacrifice His Life for us. This love is the real LOVE. This is the inner attachment and the genuine friendship. This is the love which sacrifices one's all, one's life. This is the reality of love. He accepted all these troubles.

"All this can not be accomplished by merely talking. It can not be done by saying: 'I love you' or 'How is your health' or 'You are my beloved' or 'You are esteemed'. This is not love. This is attachment that will break in the testing. This is why one sees persons associating with one another, appearently friends, expressing the greatest praise for one another, appearing to be enraptured with one another. Each seems to sacrifice himself for the other, but when they part they become as strangers. This is human love, it is not spiritual love; it is not divine love; it has no real foundation and in the time of testing it will fail and disappear.

"If you should go to Persia and mingle with the friends there and should be in the house of the friends and people should come to take you, to kill you, you would then witness how the owner of the house would sacrifice himself for you. He would sacrifice himself for you rather than allow even one hair of your head to be hurt. THIS IS LOVE! It has happened often in Persia that the friends have sacrificed themselves for one another. This has happened many times. This love is the LOVE OF GOD.

"The King of Martyrs and the Beloved of Martyrs were two souls who were greatly honored among the people. They were wealthy. They were extremely comfortable. The people pillaged their property They put them in chains. They put them in prison. The Shah of Persia decreed that they should be killed; that they should either deny their faith or be killed. The notables came to them and advised them; even the government advised them to recant so that they might save their lives. But they would not deny. They continued to cry aloud: 'YA BAHA EL ABHA!' (O Thou Glory of the Most Glorious!) And so they were martyred.

"This is the Love of God! This is the Love of the heart!

#### O thou seeker of Truth!

Whatever thou hast heretofore heard was fancy, not truth; was tradition (or narration), not vision, for it was an explanation concerning the Rising of the Sun, but that explanation was during the night.

But in this Day the Light of Truth hath dawned and the world hath become illumined; and therefore whatever thou (now) hearest concerning the Sun is on the authroity of vision (or actual sight), not on tradition (or narration). Consequently, open thine eye so that thou mayest hear the Divine Voice. Be delivered from thyself, from the thoughts and superstitions, until thou mayest find Eternal Life.

Recollect thou how many imaginations (or fancies) thou had during thy life! Now it has become evident that they were all superstitions, not Truth. Now walk thou in the Path of Truth so that the shining Lights may encompass thee and thy soul find a new life.

Be thou quit of the superstitions of the Pharisees, so that they may not prevent thee from believing in the Christ. For the Pharisees were heedless of the real purpose of the Holy Scripture, and since they did not understand the meaning of the Pentateuch, they assalled His Highness, Christ. One said: "Christ must come from Heaven; this person has come from the womb of Mary!" Another said: "He must come from an unknown place; we know this one is from Nazareth." Another said: "Where is the Kingdom of the Messish?" Another said: "Where is the iron rod?" Another said: "Where is the throne of David, and how did the Messish sit upon it?" Another said: "Where is the Justice during the days of the Messiah, and the association of the wild beasts - wolf with lamb, leopard with young goat, asp with suckling babe?"

To be brief: As they did not understand the meaning of the Holy Scripture, they did not approve of His Hollness, the Spirit of God (i.e. Christ). They opposed Him, avoided Him; nay, they made Him an ornament of the cross. They took the liberty of treating Him with the utmost injustice.

Now too, (in this Day) the heedless ones are like unto the Phanises and are not informed (or are ignorant) of the Truth of the Holy Scripture! Consequently, they oppose the Blessed Beauty (i.e. Baha'u'llah) and are of the scoffers.

Before long this Great Cause will change the dust-bin of strife, conflict and warfare into the Garden of Love, Affinity, Peace and Conciliation.

Repeatedly I write, that, if conditions continue in this manner, that is, if disagreement remain (or continue) among the belowed ones (believers) in America, the Cause of God will (thereby) entirely become extinguished (in that country) and the seed which have been sown will decay, and all will become afflicted with a manifest loss. Now is the time of teaching (the Truth): that is all!

Then the Sum of the Covenant will shine, flooding the Orient and the Occident with glorious lights, There is no opportunity to write more than this.

I hope that in the future their flame of enthusiasm and the fire of their devotion may be enkindled more than before in Faran and Boushrouyah. When this condition is obtained, the meeting will become heavenly, celestial, god-like, illumined and the means od guidance of the erring ones. It will yield most great results.

O thou servant of His Holiness Baha'u'llah! Inform all the believers that perhaps a number of calumnious articles will be sent to those parts by the people of doubts. The aim of such articles is to cause the wavering of the friends in the Covenant and the Testament. Therefore, they should not take notice of these articles; nay, rather return them to the senders, accompanied with concise, full, sweeping answers: that we are firm in the Covenant and the servants of the Blessed Perfection. We do not give ear to such hearsays and incoherent statements.

We have turned our faces to the Center of the Covenant in accord with the incontrovertible Commands of Baha'u'llah, the text of the Akdas and the text of the Tablets of the Covenant.

## Helen Bishop's letter to Mr. Lunt.

Dear Mr. Lunt .-

It is a great experience to go to Haifa, and one changes one's point of view on many matters. The Guardian is an example of how intellect can serve the spirit in a manner we of the West have never known. There is nothing emotional about the Guardian; he is a perfectly controlled and mature personality. I have never heard him recite an incident in which he was the major figure, or say anything which would in any way give him a chance to excel. This may sound very naive but the point is that Shoghi Effendi simply refutes all those theories with which our academies are surfeited; that everego is trying merely to maximate itself.

Shoghi Effendi is very impersonal and he speaks only of the Word and our Faith. His speech is rapid and his English is stunning when he speaks, the hours pass tirelessly. I should say that his most obvious characteristic is <u>Power</u>, but there is nothing arbitrary or even personal about it. Again and again he seems to convey to one that the Cause of Baha'u'llah will reach its aim and that we have only to be superlatively faithful and to be active and obedient. There is something about him that makes one believe that one can do anything if he requires it; for example, he told me to write, and somehow I simply must begin to do it.

Shoghi Effendi says that great world events will establish the Fatth. It depends only partly upon the Baha'is. The war is inevitable and great changes will result therefrom. Great Britain will lose her colonies. At present, the British Commonwealth is the greatest obstacle to the Commonwealth of Baha'u'llah. Russia will experience a change in regime. From America much can be expected. The form of the Administration established in America will become the form for the entire world. Also Germany has a great destiny. In an era of persecution they will exhibit a loyalty and devotion which makes them comparable to the Persians. Scholars, teachers and technicians from Germany will contribute much to the Baha'i Cycle.

Isn't this fascinating?

#### ADDRESS OF ABDU'L BAHA

#### to the

Theosophical Society of Scotland.

February, 1913.

It gives me great pleasure to be with you this evening and to take part in your delightful gathering, for you Theosophists, Praise be to God, are always independent investigators of reality, released from mere imitation of the customs of your forebears and ancestors. Your purpose in life is to achieve and welcome the knowledge of reality, no matter from what religion the light may dawn. The religions of today are all captives in the claws of custom and of blind dogma, for the absolute reality and dominant truth which prompted the foundation of the very religions in the past are entirely forgotten and certain blind observances of ritual and sacerdotal mummeries have crept in which are in entire opposition to the fundamental principles of Divine Religion.

True religion which comes from God, is founded for the purpose of illuminating the world of humanity and for the emancipation of the human race. It establishes a complete fellowship between all the hearts and unfolds before our vision the Kingdom of Heaven. But a thousand times, alas! Religions so founded have become the cause of contention and mutual strife, and today they are constantly waging war against each other. There is even bloodshed among their representatives, who engage in strife, ransack each other's possessions, and destroy each other's homes. What makes them do all these things? They do them because they are prisoners of blind dogma.

As an illustration, take anyone you meet. You ask him to what religion he belongs. He says he is a Jew. "Why art thou a Jew?" "Because my father was a Jew and my forebears were Jews. That is why I follow in their footsteps." Another man is a Musselman. "Why art thou a Musselman?" "My father was one, and my ancestors also." And if you put this query to the devotees of other religions they will give you the same answer. And indeed if you go through the whole category of the present-day religions you will find that in all of them numbers are following blindly; and that is a case of the "blind leading the blind". But if you inquire, you will find that they have never investigated the reality; for if they had done so, they would all have become unanimous and would work in harmony. If reality is one, then it is not subject to division; and this absolute reality is the foundation of all religions

The Theosophical Society has freed itself from such blind initation of what was thought and done in the past; and, soaring up toward the Heaven of Reality, is ever trying to investigate the deeper Truths which underlie all religions. Therefore I am very

happy.

As we look upon this world - the Macrocosm - and upon all that goes to make up men - the Microcosm - what do we find? We find that every organism is composed of single primordial atoms, and has come into existence through the interaction of the electric affinities inherent in them. Its existence is a scientific fact. Every given atom of these myriads of atoms has passed through multitudinous forms, and in every form it has manifested a particular virtue or power. For example, looking upon this flower, there is no doubt that it is composed of single atoms, simple elements. There was a time when the various substances composing it were all in the mineral kingdom, and during that period they underwent many transformations. Having completed their course in the Mineral Kingdom, these atoms ascended to the Vegetable Kingdom, and they will go on maybe for many hundreds of years continuing their journey through experiences in this vegetable life. One day this which is now a chrysanthemum may become a rose; another day it may form part of a carnation. Another day it may enter into the composition of a tree. In short, each indestructible atom goes on journeying first through the mineral kingdom, and then through successive stages of the Vegetable World. This is a fact in harmony with the laws of biology.

Now this atom having run its course through the vegetable kingdom ascends next into the Animal Kingdom, where again it has its varied experiences. Having finished these it enters the realm of humanity and travels through its many and varied stages. In short, this primordial atom has under-gone transformations through all the kingdoms and sub-kingdoms of life, and in consequence of these experiences it manifests in a certain form and possesses a particular virtue and power.

It is one of the philosophic epigrams of the East that everything is included in the All. Therefore every man during these multitudes of transformations is gradually learning to know the many aspects of that All, and in every TRANSFORMATION has the opportunity of acquiring fresh virtue, so that man may become the compendium of all the virtues of creation. This is an exposition of a Divine Mystery.

Philosophic man, or the inner man, is indestructible. He is ever existent. For the immortality of the soul is a fact not to be denied. The spirit is everlasting, it is illimitable. The rational proof of the immortality of the soul is as follows:— Man enjoys two realities, two verities (or aspects of Truth). The first aspect of this human verity is material; and the second aspect is spiritual. The aspect which is material is subject to non-existence. But the ideal aspect of man which is the spirit is indestructible. What does mortality or death mean? It means transference from one body to another body. Thus to take again the illustration of this flower; this flower you may say is doomed to death, it is dying. Why? Because it is losing its present form and is returning to its original constitution, which is mineral. But there is ever a conservation of energy lasting through all creations; so that even the

material constituents which make up this flower never die, but are constantly transformed. Thus, when grass is eaten by an animal, you may say that the grass is dead. But the real fact is that it has only lost its vegetable form and become absorbed into the animal kingdom, and through this process, animal life is made possible, the plant has never been lost.

So that we may say of annihilation that it is a process of transference from one form to another; but the elements are indestreutible. That is all that is meant by annihilation. Thus it is with the body of man, his material form that you see before you. The spirit leaving the body means that this temporal body having done its duty, will return to its original constituents and become part of the earth; but it still has an existence. So death means simply a step beyond the present conditions of life. In this way the material body of man may go through many forms and changes, and die and again be born, because it is used constantly in the making of various new forms and shapes.

At the same moment one body cannot occupy the same space as another. It may only occupy one space. Take for example, any given body - say a triangle. As long as it is a triangle, it cannot be a square, nor can it become a hexagon. It cannot become any other geometrical figure, for if it becomes a hexagon it cannot remain a triangle. One body can only be one shape at a time. So two forms cannot become part of one body at the same time. But, even as you are sitting here, your soul or mind or spirit, by whatever name you call it, contains all these various forms. At this very moment you conceive of a triangle, a square, a hexagon or a geometrical shape all at the same moment. Just at this time in your mind, in your SPIRIT, you may call up anything. There are these forms existing simultaneously, without having to be broken, and to replace one another in succession. They are all present in your spirit. In this way all forms exist in the spirit. There is no need of breaking one form, so that the spirit may enjoy another form. The spirit is independent of these forms. Therefore this is scientific proof that the spirit is eternal. Why do we enjoy the immortal spirit? It can never be transformed from one shape to another. It is able to contain all the shapes and forms in the world. This is selfevident. The spirit enjoys immortal life.

Another piece of evidence- this physical body of man, once in a while, is subject to sickness. At other times it gets well. Sometimes the body grows fat, at other times it grows the opposite way - all lean - so that the body goes through various conditions; but the spirit is ever the same. If the body grows lean the spirit grows not lean; if a man enjoys three hundred avoirdupois, his spirit does not weigh three hundred pounds. Therefore this Divine and Heavenly Absolute Reality which is in man is not subject to transformation or change. If one hand is cut off and the other arm is cut off, and the lower limbs are cut off, you will see that the man is going on living just the same, and his spirit is not mutilated. He is exactly the same man. The eternal spirit in him is undying. The third proof - what is death? Death means the losing of sensations or susceptibilities. While in a state of sleep, man's body lacks all sensation. His eyes do not see, his ears do not hear. The power of smell does not act. All the senses are at rest. They are asleep? Yet notwithstanding all this the man travels.

He journeys, he dreams. His spirit sees and his tongue speaks. In that very state of quiescence he is endowed with all his faculties. Now if man was made only of this material flesh he would not have these various conscious experiences while in a state of dream. This likewise demonstrates the fact that in the inner reality of man there is a second deeper reality by which everything is surrounded. Therefore it is another evidence that in man God has hidden another second reality, which second reality is entirely free from all the fatalities of life, ever going forward, never retrogressing; and this will show you that man enjoys this immortal and everlasting spirit.

The fourth proof: - While speaking you use the word "I". "I went there." "I came here." Who is this "I" that speaks within you? It can look out and see its own body. It is evidently the ego within (cognito ergo sum). Therefore there is a second indestructible reality in man. The fifth proof: - When you want to undertake a great thing you retire within this chamber of your own thought and wonder "Will it be profitable? Ought I to do this? What will be the result of this?" Who is this consultant within you? That consultant is the spirit. You consult with it and you get the proper opinion; and if the spirit dictates "Go and do it", you will go on and do it, and if it dictates "No. it is not profitable", you will not dare to do it. And this state is constantly working in man, and is the proof in regard to the immortality of the soul. That inner reality is the rider and your body is the charger. The body is like unto this glass, and the spirit within you is like unto the light which illumines the glass. Although the glass may be broken, the light will not be broken. Although the bulb containing the electric light goes through the process of dissolution, the light is not destroyed. It remains latent as electric energy; and another glass will come and take the place of its predecessor, and you will again have the light shining through it.

Man has had all this journeying through the various grades, and he is traveling still and will travel, until in the end he will reach a destination which is superior to his physical life. That is called the state of perfection; but he is constantly breaking these glasses and purifying them, making for himself, by degrees, a purer and purer vehicle until it becomes perfectly transparent. At one time this glass that is here before us was in the course of vitrification in the mineral kingdom. And in the same way there was a time when the constituents of our material body were in a vegetable kingdom. And at another time they were a part of animal life. Now they have come together so as to form the human body. Therefore although the glasses be shattered, the light of the spirit or the true reality will ever shine; and this is another proof. It is not a traditional proof - not a matter of belief and theory. It belongs to the philosophy of the Kingdom and it is unanswerable.

To take another line of argument: - The world of existence, the world of manifestation, by itself and in itself, cannot enjoy perpetuity. No, the phenominal world, or world of existence, has rather the capacity for receiving bounties and outpourings. There is a Reality which is central. The world of existence has emanated or issued from that central reality. As this material globe of ours - which in itself is not luminous - is vivified by rays emanating from the phenominal sun - for the sun is a star - so the spiritual rays issue from this stupendous center of life and immediately all are illumined thereby.

The greatest Divine outpouring is the appearance of Divine Masters in this world. These Divine and Heavenly Verities consist of one central Verity. But they have diverse Dawning-places; just as this electric light is always the same light, although it shines through various glasses. Here one day it shines through this glass, another day this glass is extinct and it will shine through another many glasses - but the energy which gives light is the same, without any difference. The Light is indivisible, it is one light; and although these Heavenly Masters, as far as their personalities are concerned, are different; as regards their Inner Nature they enjoy one central realm, and that one central realm emanates from the central spiritual sun. There are many mirrors from which the sun is reflected. Yet the sun is one. This is an astromomical question. For example: - Here on the map you have twelve rays issuing forth from the central body/ As you look, see that there is one center and one stellar body; but this stellar body is capable of transmitting many, many rays of light to all parts. One light gives forth these twelve rays. Similarly one sun, the phenominal sun, dawns at one time from the celestial sign of Capricorn; at another time it shines from the sign of Leo; at another time it will appear from the sign of Aries. It will shine from one point in spring, and again from another point in winter; but the sun is the same sun, and the ray is the same ray, although it passes through many signs. When the sun dawns from any particular sign, its heart is of a certain intensity. Similarly, there are differences in these Divine Manifestations, or "Masters"; but in reality they show forth the One Central Truth.

Man must never look at the Dawning-Points, he must ever look upward and see the Sun. He must be an adorer of the Sun, no matter from what Point it appears. He must recognize the Light, no matter from which Glass it has been admitted. For Light is illimitable, and man must attain to that state of divine perception. He must never limit himself to any one system. There are many mirrors reflecting the Light; but though all these mirrors should be shattered, the Light would remain. So long as we are seeking the Light and constantly turning towards it, we shall love the Light, no matter from which globe it may be shining.

And now I have made you quite tired.

O Thou Almighty God! Illumine dur minds. May the eyes of the blind be opened and the ears of the deaf unstopped. Arouse the hearts that are dead. Quicken the souls that are fast asleep.

FOUR YEARS LITICATION INVOLVING BAHA'I WORLD'S PRITITIONS (TO) PALESTINE HIGH COMMISSIONER (HAS BEEN) ABANDONED. OWNERS REQUIRE 4000 POUNDS (1.e. about \$20,000). HALF (OF THIS) SUM (IS) AVAILABLE. WILL AMERICAN BELIEVERS UNITEDLY CONTRIBUTE 1000 POUNDS (1.e. about \$5,000) BEFORE END OF MAY AND REMAINING 1000 POUNDS (1.e. about \$5,000) WITHIN NINE MONTHS. AMERICAN BEAUTHER BODY AMERICAN COMMONITY SUBORDINATE NATIONAL INTERESTS OF FAITH TO ITS URGENT PARAMOUNT REQUIREMENTS AT ITS WORLD

To this message the following reply was immediately sent: "American Baha'i community, acclaiming impressive victory which contributes to future consolidation Divine institutions, will with one heart fulfil glorious privilege conferred upon it by beloved Guardian."

In communicating this appeal to the Baha'i Community, the following brief explanation will reveal the significance of the facts which Shoghi Effendi has reported.

The "Dumit property" is an area on Mount Carmel which has seriously interfered with the Guardian's plan of safeguarding the vicinity of the Holy Shrines and of preparing the necessary land for the future construction of important world Baha'i institutions. Held by an enemy of the Faith, the property has been made the basis of law suits against the Guardian throughout the period of the last four years. In July, 1933, at Shoghi Effendi's direction, the National Spiritual Assembly sent to the High Commissioner at Jerusalem a petition setting forth the religious character of the Baha'i land on Mount Carmel and appealing for his favorable action on the Baha'i claims. That petition was not at the time reported to the believers because the Guardian wished the matter held confidential pending the final outcome.

Shoghi Effendi's cablegram, consequently, means these three things: first, that a tract of land of paramount importance to the development of the Baha'i World Center can be acquired; second, that the law suits which have interrupted that development and been burdensome are now a thing of the past; and third, that the Guardian has made a contract to purchase that area, fulfilment of which requires the American Baha'i community to contribute approximately \$5,000 to the Guardian before May 31, 1935, and an additional \$5,000 within nine months.

No Baha'i will overlook the fact that the progress of the Faith of Baha'u'llah, in its evolution to His World Order, depends upon the collective capacity of the believers to assist in strengthening the World Center at Haifa. From that Center, through the Guardian now and through the Guardian and the Universal House of Justice in the future, flows outward to the Baha'i community the spiritual inspiration and the administrative power which sustains our efforts, guides our actions and renews our souls.

As Shoghi Effendi declares: "Am compelled appeal entire body American Community subordinate national interest of Faith to its urgent, paramount requirement at its World Center."

While humanity plunges blindly forward to a destiny become inevitable, it is our most sacred and glorious privilege, our most compelling duty to Baha'u'llah Himself, to do our part in laying the foundation firmly, in true love and sacrifice, for the World Order that is to give mankind the blessing of the Most Great Peace. years of unceasing turmoil, so laden with anguish, so fraught with incalculable consequences to the future of civilization, have brought the world to the verge of calamity too awful to contemplate." (The Goal of a New World Order, page 10) "Ours, dearly-beloved co-workers. is the paramount duty to continue with undimmed vision and unabated zeal, to assist in the final erection of that Edifice the foundation of which Baha'u'llah has laid in our hearts, to derive added hope and strength from the general trend of recent events, however dark their immediate effects, and to pray with unremitting fervor that He may hasten the approach of the realization of that Wondrous Vision which constitutes the brightest emanation of His Mind and the fairest fruit of the fairest civilization the world has yet seen." (The Goal of a New World Order, page 28). And addressing the American Baha'is Shoghi Effendi has written: "In a world writhing with pain and declining into chaos this community - the vanguard of the liberating forces of Baha'u'llah - succeeded in the years following Abdu'l Baha's passing in raising high above the institutions established by its sister communities in East and West what may well constitute the chief pillar of that future House - A HOUSE WHICH POSTERITY WILL REGARD AS THE LAST REFUGE OF A TOTTERING CIVILIZATION." (America and the Most Great Peace, page 21).

Such is the significance of our united effort to fulfil the Guardian's present appeal.

Now, that the matter may proceed with all possible force and efficiency, will each local Assembly do its utmost to transmit to the National Fund a flow of special donations marked for the Guardian, that our Treasurer, well within the dates fixed in the cablegram, may in turn transmit to Shoghi Effendi the two sums he requires. For its part, the National Spiritual Assembly will forthwith meet the problem of reducing its national budget to the lowest possible amount. Above all, we express the confident hope that all American Baha'is will take part in this magnificent enterprise, this holy and consecrated crusade under our Guardian's banner, even though in many circumstances the amount given may be only a tiny sum. What we are building is a true spiritual unity - the material needs of the Faith will all be met when that unity is attained!

# O thou daughter of the Kingdom!

Thy letter was received and its contents became evident. It was an indication of a prayer and supplication and a proof of attraction and enkindlement. Happy is thy condition that thou art in this state and in this firmness.

O thou daughter of the Kingdom! The Lord of the Kingdom and the Sun of Truth has sent forth a splendor and effulgence upon the world and the universe. All the contingent things found life and existence from the rays of that Effulgence, entered and became manifest in the Arena of Being. Therefore, all the objective phenomena are as surfaces of mirrors upon which the Sun of Truth has cast the rays of the Outpouring of Bounty. All these surfaces (different stages of life) are mirrors reflecting the rays of the Sun of Truth. The Outpouring is the One Outpouring, and the Effulgence is the One Effulgence. These complex and diversified mirrors are different from each other. Some of them are in a state of the utmost purity and clearness, reflecting the rays of the Sun of Truth, and the Effulgence of the Luminary is manifest and visible in them. On the other hand there are mirrors full of dust and dark, consequently they are deprived and bereft of any radiation.

The believers of God are the translucent mirrors, who, with the utmost purity and clearness, are reflecting the rays of the Orb of regions. Other communities are bedarkened and bedimmed like unto a stone and ademant. This condition is especially true of the people of hostility, animosity, oppression and tyranny, and the fenatical ones, who, on account of the accumulation of dust (prejudice) have become like unto the black stone, into which the rays of the sun do not penetrate and from which no light radiates.

Now we must not consider nor recognize these mirrors, which are deprived of every gift, as strangers and foreigners; neither should we speak of or know them as enemies or savages; nay, rather, must we recognize them as the members of our body, showing them love and affection; not as strangers but as associates; not as foreigners but as friends. One must become engaged in their training and education, sympathize with them and show pity to them, and lead them into the Heavenly characteristics, in order that the accumulated dust may disappear from the surfaces of those mirrors and the shining rays of the Sun of Truth radiate from them.

O thou daughter of the Kingdom! Beware! Beware! Be ye not a stranger to anyone, even if he be the lowest of savages on the face of the earth and knows nothing of God, or even if he be an enemy. Desire ye his association, aspire ye for his freedom and long ye for

his perfection, in order that hatred and dissensions, animosities and oppressions, cruelties and tyrannies, brutalities and falsehoods, pride and transgressions may be removed from among mankind, the universe become the Paradise of Abha, the world be transformed into the Kingdom of Heaven, the human race become angels and the individuals of the world of humanity become the manifestors of the Favors of the Glorious Lord. This is the perfection of the human world. This is the Divine Guidance of the Almighty.

O thou daughter of the Kingdom! Display ye the utmost charity toward the poor, the orphans and the helpless ones of all communities and nations and have ye for them exceeding consideration. Serve ye them like unto the real servants. Know ye them as excellent persons, and count yourselves day and night the thralls of mankind.

O thou daughter of the Kingdom! Know thou that supplication and prayer is the Water of Life. It is the cause of the vivification of existence, and endows glad-tidings and joy to the souls. Show thou attention to this matter as far as thou canst, and summon others to prayer and supplication.

"I desire distinction for you. The Bahalis must be distinguished from others of humanity. But this distinction must not depend upon wealth - that they should become more affluent than other people. I do not desire for you financial distinction. It is not an ordinary distinction I desire; not scientific, commercial, industrial distinction. For you I desire spiritual distinction; that is, you must become eminent and distinguished from all else. You must become distinguished for loving humanity; for unity and accord; for love and justice. In brief, you must become distinguished in all the virtues of the human world; for faithfulness and sincerity; for justice and fidelity; for firmness and steadfastness; for philanthropic deeds and service to the human world; for love toward every human being; for unity and accord with all people; for removing prejudices and promoting universal peace. Finally, you must become distinguished for heavenly illumination and acquiring the bestowals of God. I desire this distinction for you. This must be the point of distinction among you."

Set aside every mention save the mention of God and abandon everything save the divulgence of the Testament, be attracted by the magnet of the Covenant that thou mayest see the triumph of the angels of the King of the Kingdom and the valor of the hosts of Might. By the Life of the Lord! the invincible power will indeed strengthen, the HOLY SERIRI will speak in thy mouth, the word of God will be revealed in thy heart, the sound of the trumpet of the Lord will gladden thee, the light of unity will shine from thy brow, the doors of success and prosperity will be opened upon thy face and the secrets of the Holy Books will be unfolded.

#### LAST TALK GIVEN BY ABDU'L BAHA.

At the House of Abdu'l Baha. Haifa, Palestine.

November 19, 1921.

Talk given by Abdu'l Baha at the regular six o'clock evening meeting, called "The Persian Meeting", with Mr. John D. Bosch of Geyserville, California, present - the only one present from a foreign country among sixty friends who met at this time - just nine days before the Ascension of Abdu'l Baha, in fact, this was the last public talk given by Abdu'l Baha in the Persian Meeting when an American attended, before His Ascension.

(Interpreted by Mirza Mohammed Ali Afnan. Taken down in Persian by Dr. Lotfullah Hakim.)

Abdu'l Baha opened the meeting by saying to Mr. Bosch:
"Although you are here with these assembled friends and can
not speak with them nor they with you, yet you speak with one another
through the heart. The language of the heart is even more expressive
than the language of the tongue and is more truthful and has wider
reach and a more potent effect."

Mr. Bosch said: "This is a wonderful spiritual experience, to be here with the friends."

Abdu'l Baha said: "When lovers meet it may be that they can not exchange a single word, yet with their hearts they speak to one another. Thus do the clouds speak to the earth and the rain comes down; the breezes whisper to the trees; the sun speaks to the eyes of men. Although this is not actual speech, yet this is the way in which the hearts of the friends talk together. It is the harmony between two persons and this harmony is of the hearts. For instance, you were in America and I was in the Holy Land; although our lips were still, yet with our hearts we were conversing together. The friends here love you very much. They have a real attachment for you although with the tongue they can not express it."

Mr. Bosch said: "I am very glad. I love them too."

Abdu'l Baha said: "If this love is real and true, if it is from the heart, it will characterize itself by self-sacrifice. When the attachment is superficial, friends do not sacrifice themselves even to the extent of a hair's breadth. His Holiness Christ LOVED both His disciples and believers to such an extent that He Sacrificed His Life for them. His Holiness the Supreme (the Bab) LOVED the friends to such an extent that He have His Life for them. The Blessed Beauty (Baha'u'llah) LOVED the friends to such an extent that for their sakes He accepted a thousand difficulties and afflictions. He was banished from place to place. His properties were confiscated. He gave all - His family, His relatives, His possessions. He accepted imprisonment, chains and fetters. His Holy Person was imprisoned in the fortress of Akka until the last moment of His Life. He was made to suffer more calamities, afflictions and difficulties than could be enumerated. He had not an hour's comfort. He was continually under the greatest hardships and ordeals. What great persecutions He endured from His enemies! What great afflictions He bore from His own relatives! He accepted all these trials for our sakes so that He might educate us, so that He might make us illumined, so that He might make us Heavenly, so that He might change our character, change our lives, so that He might illumine our inmost self. All these troubles He accepted for our sakes. He did indeed sacrifice His Life for us. This love is the real LOVE. This is the inner attachment and the genuine friendship. This is the love which sacrifices one's all, one's life. This is the reality of love. He accepted all these troubles.

"All this can not be accomplished by merely talking. It can not be done by saying: 'I love you' or 'How is your health' or 'You are my beloved' or 'You are esteemed'. This is not love. This is attachment that will break in the testing. This is why one sees persons associating with one another, appearently friends, expressing the greatest praise for one another, appearing to be enraptured with one another. Each seems to sacrifice himself for the other, but when they part they become as strangers. This is human love, it is not spiritual love; it is not divine love; it has no real foundation and in the time of testing it will fail and disappear.

"If you should go to Persia and mingle with the friends there and should be in the house of the friends and people should come to take you, to kill you, you would then witness how the owner of the house would sacrifice himself for you. He would sacrifice himself for you rather than allow even one hair of your head to be hurt. THIS IS LOVE! It has happened often in Persia that the friends have sacrificed themselves for one another. This has happened many times. This love is the LOVE OF GOD.

"The King of Martyrs and the Beloved of Martyrs were two souls who were greatly honored among the people. They were wealthy. They were extremely comfortable. The people pillaged their property They put them in chains. They put them in prison. The Shah of Persia decreed that they should be killed; that they should either deny their faith or be killed. The notables came to them and advised them; even the government advised them to recant so that they might save their lives. But they would not deny. They continued to cry aloud: 'YA BAHA EL ABHA!' (O Thou Glory of the Most Glorious!) And so they were martyred.

"This is the Love of God! This is the Love of the heart!

"O Abdul Houssein: God willing, thou wilt be confirmed and bear unto the people (the Jews) the Glad-Tidings of what was formerly revealed in the Divine Books. For this Glad-Tidings is similar to the Water of Life for the dead of the world. Blessed are they who drink thereof and wee unto those who are deprived!"

"Say: In this DAY the CITY OF GOD hath appeared and is seen in full adorment. This is the CITY wherein the GOD OF ALL is become manifest. Reflect upon the words of John, wherein he hath prophesied of the HOLY CITY: 'And I saw no temple therein, for the Lord God Almighty and the LAMB are the Temple of It. And the CITY had no need of the sun, neither of the moon, to shine in It, for the GLORY OF GOD (BAHA!U!LAH) did lighten It', and so on."

"Take the rod of resignation in the name of GOD and guide the erring people, with entire severance, to the GREAT CITY OF GOD, that peradventure the wanderers may attain to the real native lend and the blind ones receive discerning sight. Verily, He is Powerful to do that which He willeth, all things are in the grasp of His Power. Verily, He is the Mighty!"

(Tablet to the Jews, Bana'i Scriptures, page 116)

"For the Glory of God did lighten it." Consider in connection with these words the following quotations from the Fible, which add illumination to the Splendor of our subjects

"And one cried unto another: Holy! Holy! is the Lord of Hosts. The whole earth is full of His Glory!"

"Lift up your heads, 0 ye gates, and be ye lifted up, 0 ye everlasting doors; and the King of Glory shall come in. Who is the King of Glory? The Lord of Hosts. He is the King of Glory."

"And there was given Him Dominion and Glory and a Kingdom that all people. nations and languages should serve Him. His Dominion is an everlasting Dominion which shall not pass away and His Kingdom that which shall not be destroyed." (From the Book of Daniel, referring to the "Ancient of Days" or Baha'u'llah.)

Abdu'l Baha has said: "The Name of GOD which Christ gave to the disciples was the Name of the Kingdom of Baha'u'llah. It was a Kame that was never pronounced. All the Bible was written for Baha'u'llah. Everywhere, "Lord of Hosts" refers to the Manifestation."

(Baha'i Scriptures, page 444)

And Baha'u'llah has said: "Say: the Books were not revealed save for My Celebration, wherefrom every advancer will find the perfume of My Name and praise; and he who openeth the hearing power of his heart will hear from every word (of the Books), 'Lo, the truth hath come, and He is indeed the Beloved of the worlds.'"

(Baha'i Scriptures, page 96)

How clear it is then that the "Light thereof" of the Holy City, the New Jerusalem, as seen by John was the "Glory of God", Baha'u'lla:

Furthermore, Baha'u'llah has written, "O Sheikh! The Cause is so great and also the News! Meditate with clear insight and keenness upon the clear texts, the Supreme Words, and that which hath been manifested in these days, that thou mayest discover the hidden Mysteries in the Books, and to the uttermost exert thine energy in guiding the people."

"Hear with thy real hearing the declaration of Jeremiah: 'Alas, for verily that DAY is great, so that none is like it!' If thou shouldst look and reflect with the sight of equity thou wilt immediately recognize the greatness of this DAY. Hear the Voice of this Adviser, the All-Knowing and let not thy soul be excluded from the Mercy of God, which satisipated all existence - of the seen and the unseen:

"Hear what David chanted: 'Who will bring me unto the fortified CITY?" (Psalms 108: 10)

"O Sheikh! Read what Isaiah hath announced in His Book: 'O thou that bringest good tidings to Zion, get thee up into the high mountain! O thou that telleth good tidings to Jeruselem! Lift up thy voice with strength: he not afraid. Say unto the cities of Judan: Behold your GOD! Behold, the Lord God will come with Power and His Arm shall rule for Him!! (Isaiah 40: 9, 10) In this DAY all the Signs (references) are disclosed and fulfilled. The Great City hath descended from heaven and Zion is revivified and rejoiced by the appearance of the MANIFESTATION OF GOD; and it hath heard the Voice of God from all directions and places."

"Amos said: Verily, the Lord will rear from Zion and utter His voice from Jerusalem, and the habitation of the shepherds shall mourn and the top of Carmel shall withdraw."

(Amos 1: 2)

"Carmel in the Books of God is termed "The Heap of God", "The Vine of God" and sometimes the Heap of Wilderness (bewilderment); and this is the Station of the Bounty of the Manifestation. The Tent of Glory was raised upon it (Carmel) in these days; Blessed are those who advance! Also it was recorded: 'Our Lord shall come, and shall not keep silence.'"

"In the Beyan the BAB hath written: 'Verily, He (Baha'u'llah) is the One who pronounceth in all conditions and createth the winds and treadeth upon the high places of the earth. The LORD, the GOD OF HOSTS. is His Name.'"

"Isaiah said: 'And the Lord alone shall be exalted in that DAY' (Isaiah 2: 11) And concerning the greatness of the Menifestation he (Isaiah) said: 'Enter into the rook and hide thee in the dust for fear of the Lord and the Baha of His Majesty.' (Isaiah 2: 18) 'The wilderness and the desert shall rejoice and blossom as the rose. It shall blossom abundantly and rejoice even with joy and singing; the glory of Lebenon shall be given unto it, the Raha of Carmel and Sharon. They shall see the excellency of the Lord and the Raha of our God.'" (Isaiah 35: 1, 2)

"These expressions need no interpretation. They are clear like the sunshine, and like the light gleaming and radiating." (Tablet to the Oriental Jews, Baha'i Scriptures, page 120)

## WORDS OF ABDU'L BAHA.

"We are told in the Holy Scriptures that the NEW JERUSALEM shall appear on earth. Now it is evident that this celestial city is not built of material stones and mortar, but that it is a city made not with hands, Eternal in the Heavens."

"This is a prophetic Symbol - meaning the coming again of the Genting to enlighten the hearts of men. It is long since this Holy Guidance has governed the lives of humanity. But now, at last, the Holy City of the NEW JERUSALEM has come again to the world. "The greatest Power of the Holy Spirit exists in the Divine Manifestations of Truth. Through the Power of the Spirit the Heavenly Teaching has been brought into the world of humanity. Through the Power of the Spirit, Life Everlasting has come to the children of men. Through the Power of the Spirit the Divine Glory has shone from East to West and through the same Spirit will the Divine Virtues of humanity become manifest."

"Our greatest effort must be directed towards detachment from the things of the world; we must strive to become more spiritual, more luminous, to follow the Counsel of the Divine Teaching, to serve the Cause of Unity and true Equality, to be merciful, to reflect the Love of the Highest on all men, so that the light of the Spirit shall be apparent in all our deeds, to the end that all humanity shall be unified, the stormy sea thereof calmed, and all rough waves disappear from off the surface of Life's ocean henceforth unruffled and peaceful. Then will the NEW JERUSALEM be seen by mankind, who will enter through Its Gates and receive the Divine Bounty."

(Paris Talks)

Jerusalem was trodden under foot and dishonored, but the Holy of Holies was preserved, huarded and respected, and these events continued until 1280 (muhammedan time, 1844 Christian time) and as the eriod of 1280 years has expired, Jerusalem, the Holy City, is now beginning to become prosperous, populous and flourishing. Any one who saw Jerusalem sixty years ago and who sees it now, will recognize how flourishing and populous it has become and how it is again honored. This is the outward meaning of the verses of the 11th Chapter of Revelation, but they have another and symbolic sense which is as follows: The law of God is divided into two parts, one is the fundamental basis which comprises all spiritual things, that is to say it refers to spiritual virtues and divine qualities, this does not change or alter; it is the Holy of Holles which is the Essence of the Law of Adam, Noah, Abraham, Moses, Christ, Muhammed, the Bab and Baha'u-'llah, and which lasts and is established in all the Prophetic Cycles. It will never be abrogated, for it is spiritual and not material Truth it is Faith, Knowledge, Justice, Piety, Righteousness, Trustworkhiness Love of God, Inward Peace, Purity, Detachment, Humility, Meekness, patience and Cinstancy. It shows mercy to the poor, defends the wretched, gives to the appressed, and uplifts the fallen. These Divine Qualities, these Eternal Commandments will never be abolished; may, they will last and will be renewed in each of the different cycles, for at the end of every Cycle the Spiritual Law of God, that is to say the human virtues, sisappear and only the form subsists."

Briefly, what is meant by the term "Holy of Holies" is that Spiritual Law which will never be modified, altered, or abrogated and the Holy City means the meterial law which may be abrogated, and this material law which is described as the Holy City was trodden under foot for 1260 years.

#### THE SPIRITUAL NEW JERUSALEM.

We have before explained that what was most frequently meant by the Holy City, the Jerusalem of God, which is mentioned in the Holy Books, is the Law of God. It is compared to a Bride, sometimes to Jerusalem, and again to the New Heaven and New Earth. Some Revelation 21: 1, 2, 3, St. John said: "And I saw a new heaven and a new earth; for the first heaven and the first earth has passed away,

and there was no more sea. And I, John, saw the Holy City, the NEW JERUSALEM, coming down from God out of heaven, prepared as a Bride adorned for her husband. And I heard a voice out of Heaven saying: Behold, the Tabernacle of GOD is with men, and He will dwell with them and they shall be His people and GOD HIMSELF shall be with them, and be their God." Notice how clear and evident it is that the first heaven and earth signify the former law. For it is said that the "first heaven and the first earth are passed away and there shall be no more sea"; that is to say that the earth is a place of judgment, and on this earth of Judgment there is no more sea; meaning that the Teachings and the Law of God will entirely spread over the earth and all men will enter the Cause of God, and the earth will be completely inhabited by believers; therefore there will be no more sea, for the dwelling-place and abode of man is dry land. In other words at that epoch the Field of that Law will become the Pleasureground of man. Such earth is solid, the feet do not slip upon it.
The Law of God is also described as the Holy City, the NEW JERUSALEM.
It is evident that the New Jerusalem which descends from heaven is not a city of stone, mortar, brinks, earth and wood. It is the Law of God which descends from Haeven and is called New; for it is clear that Jerusalem which is of stone and earth does not descend from Heaven and that it is not "renewed" but that which is renewed is the Law of God.

The Law of God is also compared to an adorned bride who appears with most becutiful ornaments, as it is said, Reveletion 21: "And I, John, saw the Holy City, the NEW JERUSALEM, coming down from God out of heaven, prepared as a BRIDE adorned for her husband."

#### TWELVE FOUNDATION STONES.

The twelve foundation stones of the New Jerusalem seen by St. John, "And I, John, saw the Holy City, the New Jerusalem, coming down from Heaven, prepared as a Bride adorned for her husband. And I heard a Great Voice out of Heaven, saying: Behold the Tabernacle of GOD is with men and He shall dwell with them and they shall be His people and GOD HIMSELF shall be with them and be their God."

"And he carried me away in spirit to a great and high mountain and showed me a great City, the Holy Jerusalem, descending out of Heaven from God, and her Light was like a stone most precious even lik a jasper stone clear as crystal."

"And the foundations of the wall of the City were garnished with all manner of precious stones. The first foundation was Jasper; the second, Sapphire; the third, Chalcedony; the fourth, Emerald; the fifth, Sardonyx; the sixth, Sardius; the seventh, Chrysolyte; the eighth, Beryl; the ninth, Topas; the tenth, Chrysoprasus; the eleventh, Jacinth, the twelfth, an Amethyst."

"All the nations of them which are saved shall walk in the light of It; and Kings of the earth do bring their Glory and Honor into It."

These twelve foundation stones may be compared to the Twelve Baha'i Basic Principles; which are taken from the New Book of Laws revealed by Baha'u'llah, and from the foundation of the New Jerusalem. Of these principles Abdu'l Baha has said;

"The teachings of Baha'u'llah will give to hearts the necessary impulse for bestowing Eternal Life and will cause the Breeze of the Holy Spirit to blow upon you, so that with a single heart you will return to God."

"Today the promulgation of the Ideal Principles of Baha'u'llah which are manifestly recorded in the Books, is the Spirit of this Age and the Cause of the realization of Assistance and Confirmation of whosever holdeth fast to them. In whetsoever enterprise they engage they will find the doors of Might and Power flums open before their faces. His Holiness Baha'u'llah has said: 'Verily we gaze upon thee from My Abha Kingdom (Borizon), and shall come to the assistance of him who has risen to the service of My Cause with the phalanxes of the Supreme Concourse and the legion of chosen and favored angels. Thus the diffusion of the Davine Fragrances is, above all, the most important matter. I very much desire that thou shouldst visit the Holy Land and thus to meet thee, but TEACHING standing above every—thing else."

(Tablet to Eartha Root.)

"The principles of Baha'u'llah must be studied carefully one by one until they are understood and realized in mind and heart; then you will become strong followers of the Light; truly Spiritual, Heavenly Soldiers of God, sequiring and spreading the true Civilization throughout the world. This will be the Paradise which is to come on earth (the New Jerusalem) wherein all mankind will gather together und r the Tent of Unity in the Kingdom of GLORY."

"O thou yearner after the Kingdom! Each Manifestation is the Heart of the world and the proficient Physician of every patient. The world of humanity is sick, but that skillful Physician hath the healing remedy and He bestoweth Divine Teachings, Exhortations and Advices which are the Remedy of every allent and the dressing for every wound. Undoubtedly the Wise Physician discovereth the needs of every patient at every season and prescribeth suitable medicable. Therefore when thou wilt compare the Teachings of the Beauty of ABHA with the requisitions and necessities of the present time, thou wilt conclude that they are to the sick body of the world the swift healing antidote; nay, rather, they are the remedy producing everlasting health. The prescription of the proficient physicians of the past and the future will not be the same, may, rather, they will be in accord with the silment of the patient. Although the medicine is changed, yet all of these changes are for the purpose of healing the sick.

In former dispensations, the sick body of the world could not bear the strong and overpowering remedies. That is why His Holiness Chris said: 'I have many things to say unto you, but ye cannot bear them now. Howbeit, when He, the Spirit of the Comforter, who is sent by the Father, is come, He will guide you into all Truth.' Therefore, in this Age of Lights, specific Teachings have become Universal, in order that the out-pouring of the Merciful One environ both the East and the West, the Oneness of the Kingdom of humanity become manifest and the Unminosity of Truth enlighten the world of consciousness. The descent of the NEW JERUSALEM is the Heavenly Religion which secures the prosperity of the human world, and is the Effulgence of the Holy Spirit are descending uninterruptedly. The Power of the Word shall penetrate in such wise that the Latter will become the reflective mirror of the Sun of the WORD, and the radiation of the Hights of the WORD shall illuminate the whole earth. But the Howevenly Jeruselem which is established upon the apex of the world and the Holy of Holies of the Almighty, which hath hoisted Its Banner, comprehendeth and includeth in it all the Perfections and Teachings of all the former Diagensations. Likewise, it is the Herald of the Oneness of the world of humanity, the Ensign of Universal Peace, the Spirit of Eternal Life, the Lights of Divine Perfections, the surrounding bedtowals of the realm of existence, the adormment and Grandeur of the world of crestion, and the cause of the Tranquility of Humankind."

(Baha'i Scriptures, page 426)

When in London, Abdu'l Baha wrote in the old Bible in the City Temple, where He first spoke in public:
"This Book is the Holy Book of God and of Celestial Inspiration. It is the Bible of Salvation, the noble Cospal. It is the Mystery of the Kingdom and Its Light. It is the Divine Bounty and the Sien of the Guidance of God."

From this Book of "Divine Guidence" we have read in Pevelation 21: "And I saw a New Heaven and a New Earth; for the first heaven and the first earth were passed away and there was no more see."

"And I, John, saw the Holy City, the New Jerusalem, coming down from God out of heaven prepared as a bride adorned for her husband. And I heard a great voice out of Heaven saying; Behold, the Tabernacle of God is with men and He shall dwell with them and they shell be His people and God Himself shall be with them and be their GOD."

"And he carried me away in spirit to a great and high mountain, and showed me a great City, the Holy Jerusalem descending out of heaven from God, having the City of God; and her Light was like a stone most precious even like a Jasper stone clear as crystal."

"And the foundations of the wall of the city were garnished with all manner of precious stones. The first foundation was Jasper; the second, Sapphire; the third, Chalcedony; the fourth, Emerald; the fifth, Sardonyx; the sixth, Sardius; the seventh, Chrysolyte; the eighth, Beryl; the ninth, Topaz; the tenth, Chrysoprasus; the twelfth, Amethyst."

"And the nations of them which are saved shall walk in the Light of it; and the Kings of the earth do bring their glory and honor into it."

Such earth is solid and the feet do not slip upon it."

"The Law of God is also described as the Holy City, the New Jerusalem. It is evident that the New Jerusalem which descended from heaven is not a city of stone and mortar, bricks and earth and wood. It is the Law of God, which descends from heaven and is called New; for it is clear that the Jerusalem which is stone and earth does not descend from heaven, and that it is not renewed, but that which is renewed is the Law of God."

From this we learm that in each Divine Manifestation, or Cycle, a New Book of Laws is given unto man by God; through His Chosen One, or Prophet, and these Laws are both spiritual and material, constituting the New Heaven and the New Earth, according to the evolution of mankind at that particular time.

We are now living in the day of the fulfillment of St. John's revelation and the Divine Law of the New Day has been revealed to man through Baha'u'llah, God's latest Manifestation. This New Book of Laws is the New Jerukalem, and it is being built upon the sure foundation of the Word of God.

These are Twelve Basic Prinsiples upon which this New Jerusalem rests and which are most remarkable as correlated to the twelve foundation stones of the New Jerusalem of St. John's vision as regards their spiritual significances and their colors, for they are spiritual symbols and not material stones, as Abdu'l Baha has said. Let us consider them in this light.

The first Basic Principle: The oneness of the world of humanity. "Hands may be white, black, yellow or brown, but the hue of the heart is one."

The first Foundation Stone: the Jasper. It is a clear red like the hue of the human heart.

The second Basic Principle: The independent investigation of Truth. All must be free to seek out Truth in their own way.

The second Foundation stone; the Sapphire; which is a clear blue, "true blue" and the color of faith, inspiration, loyalty and truth. Man must be free to soar in this "dome" of heaven's blue and loyal to a truth when he finds it.

The third Basic Principle: The foundation of all religions is one. Each Revelator has given the same "New Heaven" and "New Earth", but man has polluted and misrepresented these Divine Laws.

In reality they are all one.

The third Foundation Stone: the Chalcedony; which is pure white, of which Abdu'l Baha has said, "While white is apparent, yet in it is hidden and concealed the seven colors. In white all colors are brothers and sisters." White is the symbol of purity, and in its origin each religion is pure, and a brother to every other religion, for all Truth is One.

The fourth Basic Principle: Religion must be the source of Unity. If it is not, its non-being is better than its being.

The fourth Foundation Stone; the Emerald; which is green. Green is the color of Harmony and Unity; there is no color known that green will not harmonize with, as the green foliage blends with every hued flower. It is the color of immortality and also of humility.

The fifth Basic Principle: Science and religion must be

united. Neither must deny the other.

The fifth Foundation Stone; the Sardonyx. This stone is red or brown according to the way it is held; so it is with Science and Religion, they are in essence one, but different in color and manifestation.

The sixth Basic Principle: The equality of men and women. They must be as the two wings of the soul, each equally developed. The sixth Foundation Stone: the Sardius; which is the stone of two layers; one is white and one is red, symbolical of the two in one.

The seventh Basic Principle: Removal of all prejudices; ra-

cial, religious, etc.

The screnth Foundation Stone: The Chrysolyte; an exquisite clear green. We read in the ancient philosophers of the "Chrysolyte Tablet". It is a symbol of absolute sincerity, and truthfulness, or purity and selflessness. Only when our hearts are free from every form of prejudice can they become the chrysolyte tablet whereon may be angraved the thoughts of our brither man.

The eighth Basic Principle: Universal Peace.
The eighth Foundation Stone: the Beryl; which is bluish green.
The blue of faith and loyalty toward out brother man, the green of
humility and unity; the harmonious blending into one symmetrical
whole, like a beautiful bouquet of flowers. This established in the
hearts of man shall also help in the stablishment of Universal Peace

The ninth Basic Principle: Universal Education.
The ninth Foundation Stone: the Topas; the glory of the sun, symbolical of the light of knowledge and the glory of wisdom, which this universal education will establish in the world when the Golden Topas Light of the Teachings of Baha'u'llah are understood and lived.

The tenth Basic Principle: Solution of the Economic Problem.
The tenth Foundation Stone: the Chrysoprasus; which is like
the Chrysolyte, a clear green which embodies truthfulness, justice,
sincerity and purity, and these are the requisites necessary for the
solution of all economic problems. The golden rule, "Do unto others
as ye would that they should do unto you."

The eleventh Basic Principle: Universal Auxiliary Language.
The eleventh Foundation Stone: the Jacinth, which is like the
Jasper, a clear red, the universal color like the hue of the heart;
and the heart of a race can only understand the heart of another when
it can speak the same language.

The twelfth Basic Principle: World Tribunal or Parliament of Man.

The twelfth Foundation Stone: the Amethyst; its color is violet. It symbolizes Spiritual Light, reverence, healing, serenity and poise. This Tribunal of all nations must be as the ultra-violet rays for the "healing of the nations", and it must seek spiritual Light in all reverence, that it may fulfill its high calling, inparting a sense of security, poise, and serenity to the hearts of all humanity.

Upon this sure foundation the New Jerusalem will be built. There is not need of man, either physical, mental or spiritual, that has not been met in the New Laws revealed by Baha'u'llah; and when they are established in the world, then indeed will the nations rejoice; then will appear that Holy City wherein "God shall wipe away

all tears, and there shall be no more death, neither shall there be any more pain, for the former things have passed away."

"And the gates of it shall not be closed at all by day for there shall be no night there; and they shall bring the glory and the honor of nations to it."

In each heart individually must this Holy City first be built, that in turn each heart may become one of the precious stones of which the Universal City of the New Heaven and Earth will be constructed, and upon the foundation of these twelve Basic Principles will it rest. Of these principles we have learned that Abdu'l Bah has said: "The Principles of Baha'u'llah must be studied one whill they are understood and realized in mind and heart; then will you become strong followers of the Light; truly spiritual, Heavenly Soldiers of God; acquiring and spreading the true civilisation throughout the world. This will be the Paradise which is to come on earth, wherein all mankind will gather together under the Tent of Unity in the Kingdom of Glory."

Reveal a New Heaven, and spread out a New Earth for habitation. Let he NEW JERUSALEM DESCEMD from on high. Bestow New Thoughts and New Life upon mankind. Endow souls with New perceptions and confer upon them New Virtues. Verily, Thou art the Almighty, the Powerful, Thou art the Giver, the Generous!

# LESSON 11, Part 1.

## THE GIFTS OF A PROPHET AND TO WHOM GIVEN.

Who is a prophet? In lesson 2, on "The Manifestation of God" this question was fully answered. We learned from the Holy Utterances of Baha'u'llah and Abdu'l Baha, and from the Bible, just who a Prophet or Manifestation was, and ever will be. That there are two degrees of Prophethood, the Universal Prophet and the Prophet who calls the people to the Universal Prophet's Teachings. The Universal Prophet gives forth a Revelation to the world. The lesser Prophet expounds this Revelation. One is a Supreme Leader and has a following, the other is a follower of the Greater One. We learned man's need of these Prophets, or Divine Shepherds, and the purpose of their coming into the world to develop the Divine Reality of man and to educate him; that the Prophet is the Educator, not the educated.

In Lessen 3, we learned of the Supreme Station from which the Reality of the Manifestation descends, and how He comes into the world, delivers His Divine Message, is despised and rejected by men, being recognized only by those who are pure in heart and free from self-seeking, and how He again ascends into the Clory of the Supreme Concourse.

Today we wish to consider the Gifts which a Divine Manifestation brings to the world and to whom they are given. He is likened unto the Tree of Life laden with precious Gifts from God to the world of humanity, from which Spiritual Reality, its Symbol: the Christmas Tree, Sprang.

Let us study well the following passages from our Holy Scriptures, dealing with the Gifts of God and later compare them with the words of Bahatu'llah and Abdu'l Baha.

## BIBLE VERSES.

"Every good gift and every perfect g ft is from above, and cometh down from the Father of Lights, with whom is no variableness, neither shadow of turning."

(James 2: 17)

"The Lord will give strength unto His people, the Lord will bless His people with Peace."

(Psalms 29: 11)

"The God of Israel is He that giveth strength and power unto His people. Blessed be God." (Psalms 29: 35)

"For the Lord God is a sun and a shield. The Lord will give grace and glory. No good thing will He withhold from them that walk uprightly. O Lord of Hosts (Baha'uvillah), blessed is the man that trusteth in Thee." (Psalms 64: 11, 12)

"For the Lord giveth wisdom, out of His Mouth cometh knowledge and understanding. He layeth up sound wisdom for the righteous. He is a buckler to them that walk uprightly."

(Proverbs 2: 6, 7)

"Every man should eat and drink and enjoy the good of his labors; it is a gift from God."
(Ecclesiastes 3: 13)

Thus saith the Lord: "And I will give them one heart, and I will put a new spirit within you; and I will take the stony heart out of their flesh, and will give them an heart of flesh: That they may walk in My statutes, and keep mine ordinances, and do them: and shall be My people and I will be their God."

(Ezekial II: 19, 30)

(Here obedience is again emphasized.)

"The wages of sin is death, but the Gift of God is Eternal Life through Jesus Christ our Lord." (Romans 6: 23)

Here we strike the tap-root o this vital question. All these gifts come through Christ, or through the Manif station. The Abstrac Essence, or Divine Reality, can only manifest Its Attributes and Divine Gifts through the Prophet or Divine Manifestation. Jesus bears out this truth in these, His words: "Jesus answered and said unto her, 'If thou knewest the Gift of God and Who it is that saith to thee: Give me to drink, thou wouldst have asked of Him and He would have given thee Living Water." (John 4: 10)

"Repent and ye shall receive the gifts of the Holy Ghost. For the promise is unto you and to your children and to all that are afar off, even as many as the Lord our God shall call." (Acts 2: 38, 39)

"Peter said unto them, 'Thy money perish with thee because thou hast thought that the Gift of God may be purchased with money." (Acts 8: 20)

"And by their prayers for you, which long after you, for the exceeding grace of God in you. Thanks be unto God for this unspeak able Gift."

(11 Corinthians 9: 14, 15)

"For by grace are ye saved, through Faith, and that not of yourselves; it is a <u>Gift of God."</u> (Ephesians 2: 8)

"Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit which is of God, that we might know the things that are freely given to us of God, which things also we speak not in the words which man's wisdom teacheth, but which the Holy Ghost teacheth, comparing spiritual things with spiritual. But natural man receiveth not the things of the Spirit of God, for they are foolishness unto him; neither can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned.

"If any man lack wisdom, let him ask of God that giveth to all men liberally, and it shall be given him."

(James 1: 5)

"Having then gifts differing according to the grace that is given us, whether prophecy, let us prophesy according to the prohibition of faith; or ministry, let us wait on our ministering; or he that teacheth, on teaching; or he that exhorteth, on exhortations; he that giveth, let him do it with simplicity; he that ruleth, with diligence; he that showeth mercy, with cheerfulness."

(Romans 12: 6-10)

"Now, concerning spiritual gifts, brethren, I would not have you ignorant... Now, there are diversities of gifts, but the same spirit. For to one is given by the Spirit the word of wisdom, to another the word of knowledge by the same Spirit. To another faith yothe same Spirit; to another the gift of healing by the same Spirit; to another the working of miracles; to another prophecy; to another discerning of spirits; to another divers kinds of tongues; to another the interpretation of tongues, but all these worketh that one and the self-same Spirit, dividing to every man severally as He will."

"For as the body is one and hath many members, and all the members of that one body, being many, are one body, so also is Christ. For the body is not one member, but many. If the foot shall say, because I am not the head, I am not of the body, is it therefore not of the body? And if the ear shall say, because I am not the eye, I am not of the body, is it therefore not of the body? If the whole body were an eye, where were the hearing? If the whole body were hearing, where were the smelling? But now hath God set the members every one of them in the body, as it hath pleased Him. Now are they many members, but one body. And the eye cannot say unto the hand, 'I have not need of thee', nor again the head to the feet, 'I have no need of you.' Nay, much more, those members of the body which seem to be more feeble, are necessary. And whether one member suffers, all members suffer with it; or one member be honored, all members rejoice with it.... Are all prophets? Have all the getts of

healing? Do all speak with tongues? Do all interpret? But covet earnestly the Best Gifts, and yet show I unto you a more excellent way."

(1 Corinthians 12: verses throughout the Chapter.)

Paul tells us to "covet earnestly the Best Cifts", then adds, "yet show I unto you a more excellent way." Even to desire for one's self the "best gifts" is tinged with selfishness. Forgetting self, all things become ours through love and service, and to all humanity, accepting that which pleaseth God, with joy and gratitude and "radiant acquiescence."

## REJECTION OF THE PROPHET.

Jesus said to His disciples: "He that receiveth a Prophet in the Name of a Prophet shall receive a Prophet's reward."
(Matthew 10: 41)

And, "He came unto His own, and His own received Him not. But as many as received Him, to them gave He power to become the Sons of God, even to them that believed on His Name; which were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God."

From these words we find the reward or gifts of a Prophet are bestowed upon those who "receiveth Him", believe on His Neme, are "born again" through the Spirit of Faith, and receive the <u>power to become</u> the Sons of God. How clear are the words of Jesus to the woman at the well, of whom He asked a drink, in the light of the above verses: "If thou knewest the Gift of God (Eternal Light) and who it is that saith to thee "Give me to drink", thou wouldst have asked of Him and He would have given thee Living Water."

BAHA'U'LLAH'S WORDS CONCERNING THE "GIFTS OF GOD" THROUGH HIS CHOSEN MANIFESTATION.

<sup>&</sup>quot;I testify that verily Thou hast fulfilled Thy Covenant and sent forth Him whose Manifestation was announced by Thy Prophets, Thy Chosen Ones and Thy Servants. Verily He hath come from the Horizon of Might and Power with the Banner of Thy Signs and with the Standards of Thy Fridences.... He hath arisen in the Most Mighty Steadfastness and spoken in the Loftiest Voice, saying: 'The Giver of Gifts hath indeed come, riding on the cloud. Advance, Oye people of the earth, with shining faces and illumined hearts.'"

## TREE OF REWARD - THE REAL CHRISTMAS TREE.

"This Oppressed One now speaks of one of these instances, thus conferring the hidden benefits of the "Tree of Reward" for the sake of God upon His servants, so that the mortal temples may not be deprived of the Immortal Fruits, and may perchance attain to a sprinkling of the never-failing flivers of the Lord of Glory. This is a food whereby brilliant souls and minds find Eternal Life, and this is that Table of which it is spoken: "O our Lord, cause to descend upon us Food from Heaven." This food is never withheld from those who deserve it and is never exhausted. It grows continually from the Tree of Grace and descends from the heavens of Justice and Mercy. Alas, that man should withhold himself from this Excellent Cift and deprive himself of Eternal Bounty and Perpetual Life."

#### GIFT OF MEETING WITH GOD.

"By meeting these Holy Lights, the "meeting of God" is attained; through their knowledge, the Knowledge of God, and by their face, the Face of God.... Therefore, whoseover is favored by these sinning and glorious Lights and hath attained to these luminous and radiant Sums, during every Manifestation, hath attained the 'meeting of God' and entered the City Eternal and Immortal Life. This 'mmeeting' cannot be realized by any except in the Resurrection Day, which is the Rise of the Self of God in His Universal Manifestation."

# WORDS OF ABDU'L BAHA.

Having traveled the path so far; having become acquainted with the "Hidden Mysteries", the "Inner Significances", the Divine Realities and the "Ciffts of God" through realization and steadfastness, real and endeavor, the student is now ready to reinforce his efforts, comfort his heart and soul, become inspired and illumined with the Light of Joy through the Golden Promises and confirming Prophecies given unto us by our Beloved Master, Abdu'l Baha, the "Sign of the Gift of God". Let us read and reread the following words, and feed on them in our heart and be thankful: To a believer in America, He wrote: "Know thou that all the promises of Abdu'l Baha are true, and His instructions are Inspirations of the Holy Spirit, and received as suggestions from Baha'u'llah. Be assured that what I have said will come to pass." And to another believer He wrote: "Once the believers continue to live in accord with my advice and teachings, there will appear in their words a most miraculous power and effect."
