## SPECIFIC INSTRUCTIONS FOR FRANCE RECEIVED FROM THE GUARDIAN BETWEEN APRIL 15 and APRIL 23, 1957-HAIFA.

When Shogki Effendi spoke of the 1000 and more telegrams he had received on the first day of Ridvan regarding the formation of Assemblies, he turned to me and said "where is the cable from Orleans?" I assured him I would send a cable to him upon my return if the Assembly had been formed. He said the NSA sould be formed with only five LSA's. England had only three when it formed its NSA.

One of the characteristics of the Guardian is his amazing memory. He has statistics of every kind pertaining to activities in all as of the world at his finger tips and he quotes them constantly. He is especially happy over the progress of the Faith in the Pacific area. It surpasses even Africa now....He kept reiterating the goals ...progress made, which surpassed, or when they lagged.
